

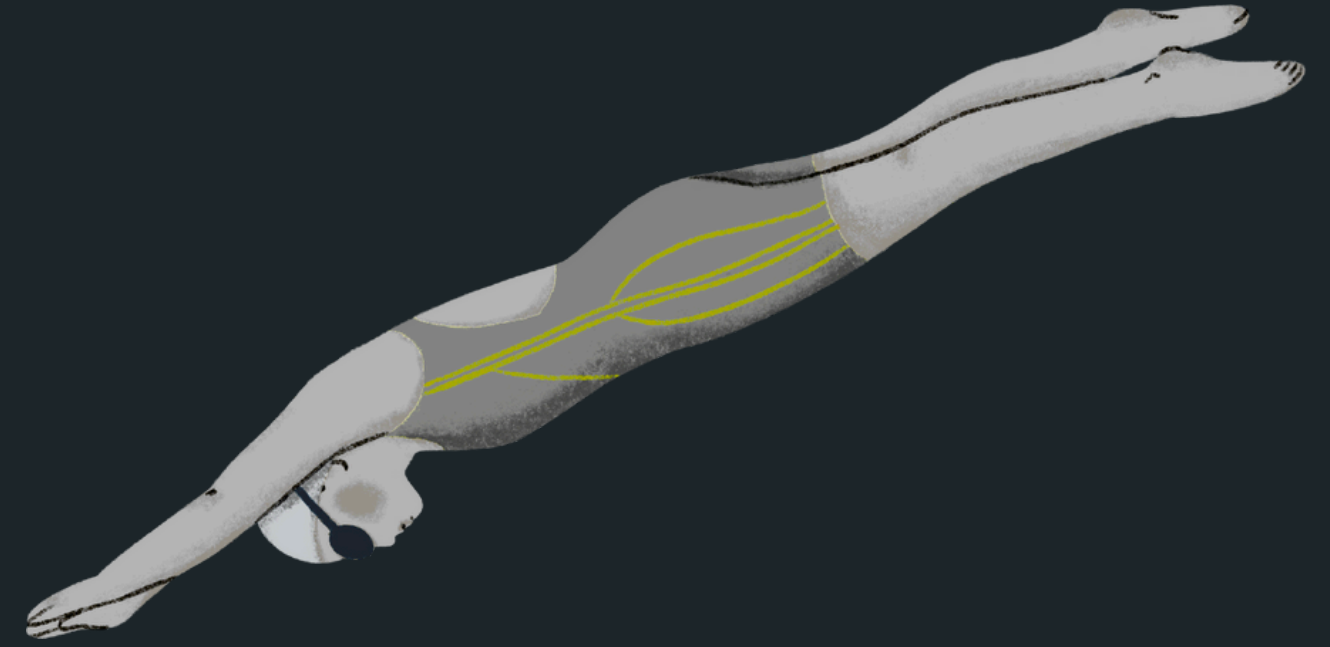

We are not-for-profit and exist to provide young people with the opportunity to take part in a healthy sport and to compete to a high level. We continually strive to help young children, youths and adults take part in a physical sport that supports physical and mental health.

Swimming is Britain's most popular participation sport; it's also one of our most successful Olympic sports. Atlantis began in 1979 and we are proud of our achievements over the last 45 years. Atlantis is now one of the strongest and most prominent swimming clubs in Sussex. With your continued support, we hope to continue to grow while maintaining our position as one of the most successful clubs in the area.

We provide a structured, safe, motivating and friendly environment in which all our swimmers have the opportunity to realise their full potential. We offer swimming training and competition for all ages 7 and above. Competitive Teams

- We have the Atlantis Artistic (Synchronised) Swimming Team Flamingos regularly achieving National success.
- Atlantis enter teams in the National Arena and the Sussex League rounds
- Number of spectators at these meets can be upward of 250 as they comprise of multiple swimming clubs.
- We have had numerous Newspaper articles written on our successes and a local magazine that have previously written about Atlantis and our talented squad members. We hope to achieve further press coverage in the near future.



OUR SWIMMING CLUB OFFERS:



- Current membership of 320 including 74 volunteers and coaches and 201 competitive and artistic swimming members.
- Club swimmers competing in Club Championships and in excess of 20 external competitions each year.
- Access to an average of 300 spectators per competition
- A large number of swimmers qualifying and medalling at County and Regional Championships. The Club also has swimmers that qualify to swim at the British National Championships together with a number of our elite swimmers selected by Sussex County to compete at the Inter County Championships.
- Winners of the Sussex League and for the third consecutive year. Retain position in the Premier League of the National Arena League
- Links to local swim schools and swimming programmes, including The ESSA Secondary Schools National Team Championships.
- These links with the local swimming community programmes reaches parents and businesses in the local community.

SPONSORSHIP

A LITTLE BACKGROUND.....

We have been successful in fundraising projects and recently raised over £10,000. We are now looking to forge a mutual beneficial partnership with a company to ensure the future of this much loved swimming club.

- Our fundraising projects raised over £10,000 and gained favourable media coverage during a 24hour swimathon.
- These funds have paid for: 4 Coaches to continue their coaching qualifications /12 Swim Bridges/1 Backstroke Ledge £729/Replacement t-shirts for all 14 Coaches/AOE cable /mixing deck for PA sound system
- SPONSORSHIP - will ensure we are still able to offer value for money for our members in the current climate while providing the best possible standard of coaching and equipment.

Previous Fundraising was to replace the lost revenue from the Open Meets and lost fees from new members during Covid. However, we now face another challenge: Swim England recently stated that the cost of living crisis is compounding the problems caused by the pandemic. Soaring energy prices will impact recruitment due to necessary rises in membership fees that are inevitable due to pool hire increases, this will affect the number of new members we can attract to swimming and competing.





Swimming is not just a sport for life but an arena where children learn to develop important life skills such as social engagement, resilience and determination. Atlantis offers young children, adults and masters a chance to join a swimming club; to have fun, enjoy competing and benefit physically and emotionally from this rewarding sport. It is paramount that grassroot sports are able to continue and promote sport through inclusion and encompass all local communities.
