


## **MORE NEWS ...**

Did you know that when a swimmer competes at a licensed meet, they can compete for a licensed time and FINA points which are uploaded to Swim Englands Individual Rankings Website www.swimmingresults.org/individualbest/

Here you can view your swimmers Individual best times and all time progress by event with nice graphs. We have a number of events throughout the year including our own Club Championships which allow swimmers to gain licensed times. Licensed times are used to qualify for entry into licensed events and, if within the qualifying times, go towards qualification to County and Regional Championships

Chloe Butler will be competing in the British Championships at the London Aquatic Centre on 15th and 17th of April. Chloe will be competing in the 200 Butterfly and 200 Breaststroke events.

Val used to swim for fitness every day (Monday to Friday) before going to her office job in Huntingdon. A group of friends from those sessions decided to swim 3K at the Great East Swim event in 2011. The next month, Val swam 3K at the ASA East Region Open Water Championships and won a masters' age group gold medal.

Val has enjoyed open water swimming in rivers, lakes and the sea. Her favourite holiday is swim training camp at the Barcelo Active Resort in Lanzarote with sessions in the 50m pool and in the sea; the highlight being the Ironman course (2 laps is 3.8K) in Puerto del Carmen. Val has also competed in the Colonia Classics races in Majorca several times. Her most successful year was 2017 when she was fastest lady in her age group in all of the Great Swim events and she won the age group gold medal at the Swim England National Masters' Open Water Championships.
