



## **Tilehurst Swimming Club**

**Affiliated to South East Region, Swim England**

**TSC Summer SC Open Meet**  
**Level 3 License: 3SE260745**  
**Saturday 6th June 2026**  
**Warmup at 7.45am, Racing starts 8.30am**

5 lane, 25m pool equipped with anti-turbulence lane ropes. Depth: 2m. Electronic timing. No secondary strobe available. All events will be conducted in accordance with Swim England laws, regulations and technical rules for swimming.

**Venue: Crosfields' Swimming Pool, Shinfield Road, Reading RG2 9BL**

1. All competitors must be a Club Compete member of an affiliated club, as defined by Swim England Law and may enter in the name of one club only. Swim England registration numbers must be included on all entries.
2. Swimmers must be or have applied to be registered with Swim England as a Club Compete athlete, and may only enter events in their own age group.
3. Classified swimmers are welcomed. If you hold a Certificate of Swimming Disability (signed by the Swim England Medical Officer) or a Functional Ability Care, please submit it to the Referee via the Promoter before the warm-up.
4. The One Start rule will apply. All events will be run on a Heat Declared Winner (HDW) basis.
5. Colorado CTS6 electronic timing will be used.
6. Results will be uploaded to Swim England rankings after the meet.
7. The closing date for entries will be **Friday 22nd May 2026**
8. Age as of **Saturday 6th June 2026**.
9. Age groups: 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15 years and above. Medals will be awarded to the top 3 swimmers in each age group/gender category
10. Backstroke ledges will be available.
11. Any dispute related to a matter not covered in these conditions will be determined by the Promoter. The Promoter reserves the right to amend the Meet Programme should this be required to facilitate the smooth running of the event.
12. The pool is 25m long, 2m deep; starting blocks are 0.75m above the water level.

### **Competing Categories**

In accordance with Swim England rules, swimmers will be required to swim in one of two groups: Female or Male/Open. The Female category is for birth sex females in accordance with Swim England's Transgender and Non-Binary Competition Policy. By entering the 'Female' category, a swimmer confirms that their birth sex is female.

## Events offered

50m, 100m and 200m: Freestyle, Breaststroke, Butterfly, Backstroke  
200m Individual Medley

## Entry fee

**£8 per event (including the Regional Swim Levy)**

## Entries

Entries will open at **8pm Monday 20th April 2026** and close at midnight on **Friday 22nd May 2026**. Entries will be accepted from clubs within the BSBASA area first. Any places remaining after the closing date will be made available to any entries we have received from clubs or individuals outside the BSBASA area.

1. All swimmers will be placed into heats based on their submitted entry times, slowest to fastest.
2. Entries must include accurate date of birth and Swim England registration number details. The name and club for each swimmer must exactly match those registered with Swim England, to ensure successful upload of results to the Rankings database.
3. Club entries *must* be made in an electronic format using the Hytek Team Manager entry software. The entry file set will be available for download from **Monday 9th March 2026** on the [TSC website](#).

4. Correct payment for entry fees and coach/TM passes should be paid by direct bank transfer (please use your club name as a reference so that we can identify your payment).

5. The Promoter reserves the right to restrict entries to meet allocated pool time or on health and safety grounds. Any entry not accepted will be refunded in full.
6. Clubs are responsible for ensuring adequate provision for supervision of their swimmers is made in line with Swim England Supervision Policy for Coaches Team and Chaperones ([here](#))
7. Details of accepted entries will be posted on the TSC website and circulated to attending clubs as soon as possible after closing.
8. The submission of entries will indicate acceptance of these Conditions.

Tilehurst Swimming Club reserves the right to restrict entries, to ensure the gala runs to schedule and venue capacity.

Refunds for rejected swims will be sent back to the respective clubs.

### Supervision of Swimmers who are not members of Tilehurst Swimming Club

Individual entries should be accompanied by a qualified Team Manager & Coach in line with the Swim England Team Manager, Coach and Chaperone policy (SE1048) effective 1st September 2023. If you are unable to meet this requirement you must request supervision from Tilehurst Swimming Club. Tilehurst Swimming Club reserves the right to reject entries after the closing date if we are unable to meet the required supervision ratios on top of our own club swimmers. If you are entering independently, please indicate whether TSC supervision is required when completing your [online entry form](#).

### Event Programme:

\*Please note that the session timings below are subject to adjustment, depending on the number of entrants. Accurate session details will be confirmed by Tuesday 26th May 2026. Heats will be run with all ages seeded together by entry time; slowest swimmers will swim first.

Swimmers will be responsible for reporting to the stewarding area in good time for the start of their race. Starts will be 'over the top' where possible, at the referee's discretion.

### Withdrawals

In order that the meet runs as smoothly as possible, a withdrawal system will be in operation. Club representatives should submit withdrawals via the withdrawal form for swimmers who are not intending to swim, by 6pm on **Friday 5th June 2026**, via the Google Form on the TSC website event page. There will be no refund of entry fees to swimmers who withdraw from events after the closing date of **Friday 22nd May 2026**, unless the swimmer has a valid medical certificate.

### **Coach/Team Manager Passes**

Passes for poolside access for the meet will cost **£15.00**. This fee includes lunch and refreshments. Only competing swimmers and swimming coaches/Team Managers with a valid pass will be allowed in the poolside area. Clubs should adhere to the mandatory ratios of qualified/DBS checked coaches and Team Managers to swimmers on poolside as per the new Coach and Chaperones guidelines from swim England. Visiting clubs must ensure that sufficient fully qualified coaches and Team Managers are present poolside 15 minutes before the warmup, to meet Swim England supervision ratios.

### **Safety**

All participants must observe the safety measures in operation at Crosfields' Pool. Swimming clubs are responsible for the supervision and behaviour of their swimmers at all times during the meet. All attendees should ensure that they listen carefully to the Swim England safety announcement which will be made at the start of the warmup.

### **Consideration times:**

Below are the upper time limits in each age group for this gala. To compete in this meet, the swimmer's last time must be slower than these times. Where swimmers do not currently have a recorded time for a particular event (NT), TSC will accept reasonable time estimates.

### **Warmup**

There will be a warmup before each session. Coaches must supervise their swimmers during this period. Swimmers age will be categorised based on their age on the day of the meet, Saturday 6th 2026.

### Results:

In the event of a swimmer having a query about results, they should raise this with their coach during the event; swimmers and their families should not directly raise issues about results with either the Swim England Officials, or the TSC Meets Technical Team. The referee's decision is final.

### Technical Officials

### Spectators

There will be a spectator fee of £5. Spectator numbers are limited to one adult per swimmer, due to space constraints at Crosfields' Pool.

### Access to changing rooms and bag storage

For the safety and welfare of swimmers, parents/supporters are not allowed in the changing rooms at any time during the meet. If parental access is required to support a swimmer, please contact the club to arrange suitable facilities. Use of photographic equipment and mobile phones is strictly prohibited in the changing rooms. Swimmers must wear suitable clothing and footwear on the poolside. Wet clothing is not allowed in the spectator area. Swimmers aged 18 years of age or above on the day of the meet must change in the adult designated changing rooms located in the Swimming Pool Reception area.

### Use of Personal Data

Entry and results data for this meet will be held on computer. The data collected will include name, date of birth, swimming club membership, gender, email address, swimming times, Swim England number and any other data collected as part of the entry process. Submission of an entry implies consent to the holding and use of this personal information by Tilehurst Swimming Club, as required by the 2018 General Data Protection Regulations.

This information (together with the meet results) may be used:

- to contact entrants and their clubs regarding entries and the running of the meet
- in the meet programme, which will be circulated to clubs and swimmers attending the meet, and will also be available to print and download on the TSC website
- in the meet documentation used by officials on the day of the meet
- to publish results at the meet venue and on the TSC website
- to submit results and rankings to Swim England

By entering the meet, entrants are consenting for their data (and that of the swimmers) to be used as above, and are accepting and agreeing to abide by these conditions.

### **Photography and safeguarding**

TSC must be mindful that images of children and adults can be misused and sharing images widely without consent may betray a confidence or identify a child or adult, which could present a risk of harm to that individual. This meet will be run in accordance with the [Swim England Wavepower guidelines](#).

All those attending the meet are reminded that mobile phones and other electronic devices that can record images must not be used in the changing room at any time during the meet and should be kept in either a bag or pocket.

Parents and carers of participants in our meet who wish to take images are requested to focus on their own children as much as reasonably possible and to avoid including other children in images. Whilst it is acknowledged that parents/carers may wish to photograph and/or record their own children when taking part in galas, it should be recognised and respected that other families may not wish for their child's image to be taken and shared in this way. Therefore, please do not post any images that include any swimmers other than your own child on social media platforms. No photography is permitted in the wetside area of the pool.

Should you have any concerns about photography or filming at the event please bring this to the immediate attention of either Ian Whitney or Abbie Green by going to the Tech Desk at the starting block end of the pool.

Tilehurst Swimming Club is committed to ensuring that all children who participate in our galas can take part in an enjoyable and safe environment.
